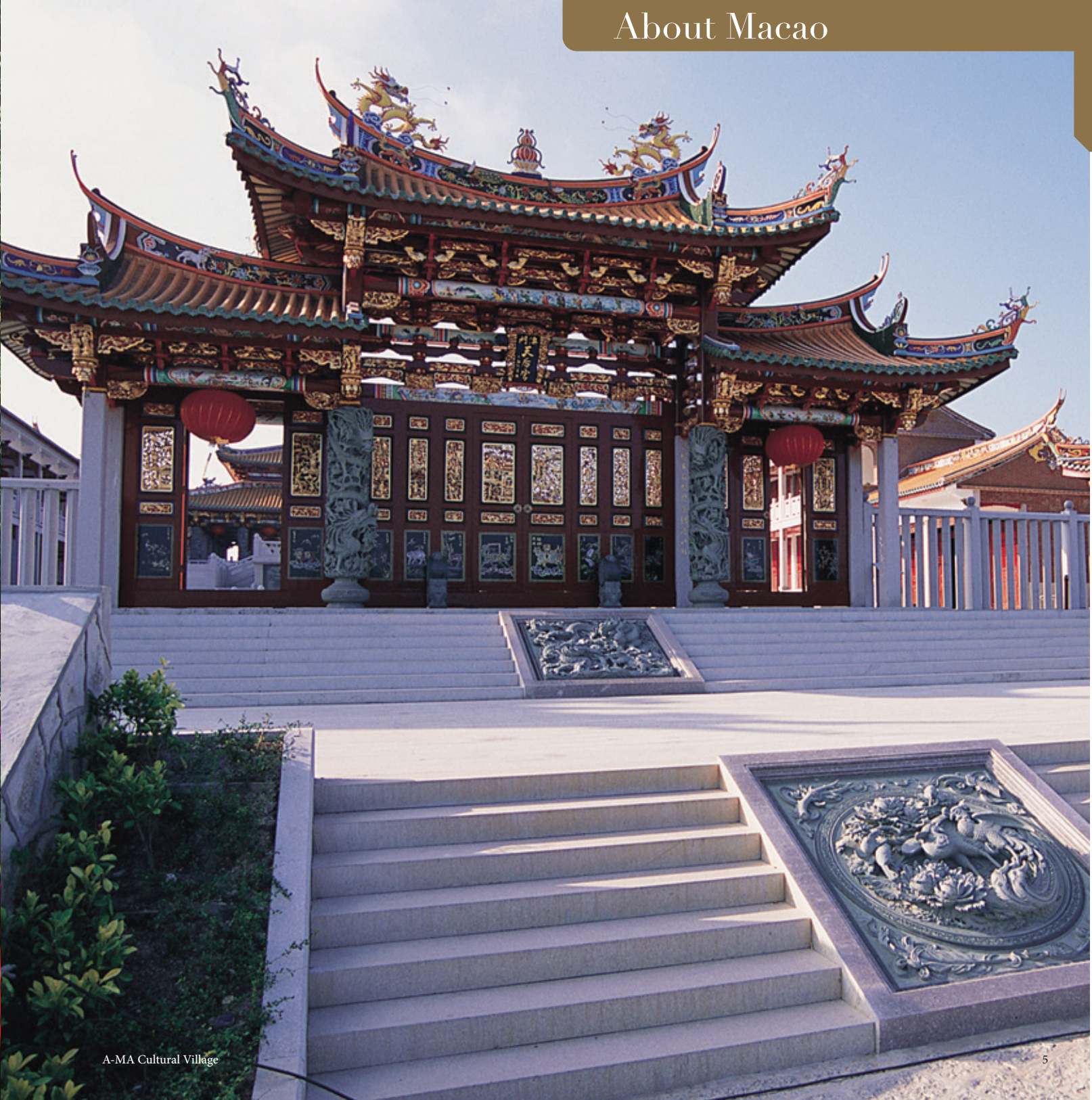

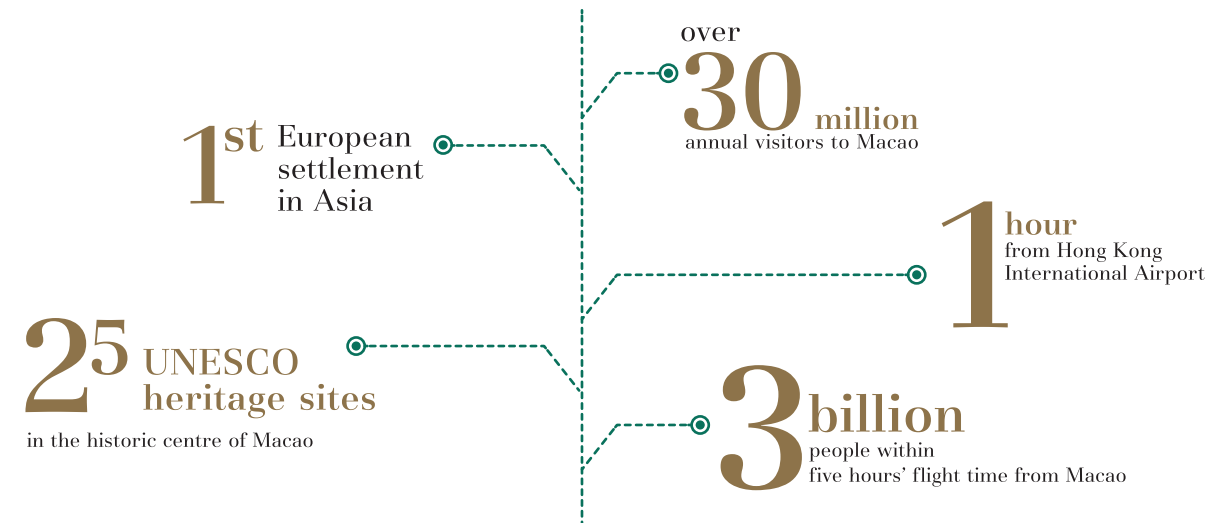

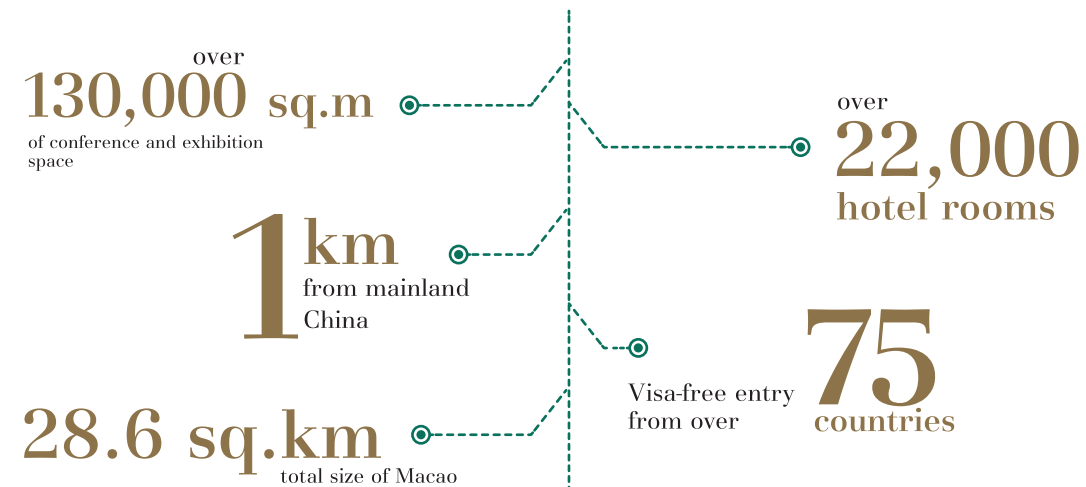

# History



Ruins of St. Paul's

Chinese fishermen and farmers formed the first recorded communities to settle in Macao, then known as Ou Mun, or “trading gate”, because of its location at the mouth of the Pearl River downstream from Canton (modern day Guangzhou). During ancient times, this port constituted part of the legendary Silk Road, with ships there taking on board silks bound for Rome, silver for Japan, and all manner of exotic spices for near and far.

In the early 1550s the Portuguese reached Ou Mun, which the local population also called “place of A Ma”, in honour of the Goddess of Seafarers, whose temple stands to this day at the entrance to the sheltered Inner Harbour. The Portuguese adopted the name, which gradually became “Macao”, with the permission of Guangdong’s mandarins, and established a city that within a short time became a major hub for trade between China, Japan, India and Europe. Macao became the natural crossroads for the amalgamation of Eastern and Western cultures.

Today, Macao is a Special Administrative Region of the People’s Republic of China, and, like Hong Kong, benefits from the principle of “One Country, Two Systems”. In the modern era, Macao developed industries such as textiles, footwear, electronics, toys, financial and banking services, in tandem with a world-class tourism industry offering a wide choice of hotels, resorts, sports facilities, restaurants and entertainment options.

# Why Macao

## Business Opportunities

Located on the doorstep of China, Macao offers unprecedented business opportunities for meeting planners and business visitors. Across the border from Macao, there are approximately 105 million people in Guangdong province, which is one of China's most prosperous regions. There are also about 200 million people in Lusophone countries that share a common Portuguese colonial legacy with Macao. Over three billion people are within five hours flight time from Macao, and many of them belong to emerging markets that have shown sustained and rapid economic growth. In 2005, the Historic Centre of Macao was officially listed as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. It is the oldest, most complete and consolidated array of European architectural legacy standing intact on Chinese territory.

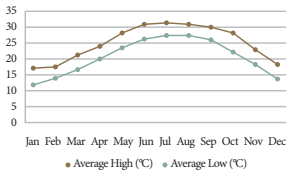
# Visitor Essentials

## Currency

Pataca (MOP) is Macao's official currency and is linked to the Hong Kong dollar (HKD). The exchange rate is MOP103.20 = HKD100.00. Roughly MOP8 is equivalent to USD1.

## Climate

Macao has a fairly warm tropical climate. Autumn (October – December) is the most pleasant season. Days are sunny and warm and humidity levels are low. Winter (January – March) is cold but sunny. In April, humidity increases and from May to September the climate becomes hot, humid and rainy with occasional tropical storms (typhoons).



## Electricity

Electricity in Macao is 220V, 50Hz. The power plugs used in Macao are of the three-pin, square-shaped (British) type.

## Languages

Chinese and Portuguese are the official languages, Cantonese being most widely spoken. The official languages are used in government departments in all official documents and communications. English is generally used in trade, tourism and commerce.

## Population

The total population is estimated at around 607,500. About 94% are ethnic Chinese, from different provinces, namely Guangdong and Fujian. The remaining 6% includes Portuguese and other nationalities.

## Tax Requirements for Foreign Congress Organisers

## Time

Macao is eight hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) in winter time.

## Transportation

Bus: Macao operates modern air-conditioned buses that connect Macao Peninsula with the island of Taipa/Cotai/Coloane. Bus fare is from MOP3.2 (USD0.40) depending on the distance travelled. Most hotels operate their own fleet of complimentary shuttle bus service between the hotels, the ferry terminals, Macau International Airport and mainland China border gates.

Taxis:

All taxis are licensed metered taxis.

## Complimentary Shuttle Bus

Sands® Resorts Cotai Strip Macao (Sands Resorts) operates the largest fleet of shuttle buses and coaches in Macao. Complimentary shuttle bus service is provided to the public to and from other hotels at Cotai Strip, Macao Peninsula, the ferry terminals, Macau International Airport, and all mainland China border gates every 10-15 minutes daily.

## Visa Policy & Procedures

Macao offers visa-free entry for nationals from more than 75 countries, which are:

- Albania, Andorra, Austria, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Cape Verde, Croatia, Czech Republic, Cyprus, Denmark, Dominica, Egypt, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Grenada, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Lebanon, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Mali, Malta, Mauritius, Mexico, Moldova, Monaco, Mongolia, Macedonia, Montenegro, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Tanzania for stays up to 90 days and United Kingdom for stays up to 120 days;
- Nationals of Australia, Canada, Chile, India, Indonesia, Kiribati, Malaysia, Monaco, Namibia, New Zealand, Philippines, Russia, Samoa, San Marino, Seychelles, Singapore, South Africa, Thailand, The United States of America, Turkey and Uruguay for stays up to 30 days;
- The following holders can use their valid passport or travel documents to enter Macao:
  - Holders of "Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card" or "Hong Kong SAR Re-entry Permit" – Valid "Hong Kong Identity Card"
  - Nationals of China with valid Macao entry/departure documents
  - Holders of Consulate / Diplomatic documents issued by Macao SAR or Hong Kong SAR
  - Holders of Diplomatic Passport
  - Holders of "Laissez Passer" issued by the United Nations; in the course of duty
  - Holders of travel documents issued by the Portuguese authorities for foreign citizens

All visitors must hold a valid passport or travel document, and note that the validity of this document must not be less than 30 days from the date of entering Macao.

The above information is for reference only. For further information on entry formalities, please contact your local embassy/consulate. If delegates want to travel to mainland China, visas may be obtained at any of the China Travel Service (CTS) offices in Macao. Visas can also be obtained at the Gongbei Immigration and Customs (after the Border Gate).

# Accessibility

Macao is adjacent to the southern province of Guangdong, China, on the western bank of the Pearl River Delta. The Macau Special Administrative Region (SAR) has an area of 28.6 sq.km, comprising the Macao Peninsula (9.3 sq.km and connected to mainland China), and the island of Cotai/Taipa/Coloane (19.3 sq.km). Three bridges connect these islands, ranging from 1-2 kilometers in length. To give an indication of size, all of Macao fits twice into Manhattan Island and three times into the city of Paris. Land access to mainland China is through the Barrier Gate and the Cotai Frontier Post, with more entry points planned in the near future.

## Arriving in Macao by Air

**Macao International Airport (MFM)**  
Visitors can use the Macau International Airport for travelling to several destinations in the region on direct flights or catch connecting flights to different ports on all 5 continents. **Transport from Macau International Airport**  
Sands Resorts provides transfer services which can be booked in advance or arranged upon arrival. A taxi ride from the airport to Sands Resorts cost approximately USD4.

## Arriving in Macao by Ferry

**Hong Kong International Airport (HKG)**  
For delegates arriving via Hong Kong International Airport, there is an airport ferry service available. Passengers can transit into or out of Macao via Hong

Kong International Airport without needing to go through Hong Kong Customs and Immigration formalities or pick up their baggage. All bags will be transferred from their international flight directly onto the ferry for collection in Macao. The trip to Macao is only 70 minutes. 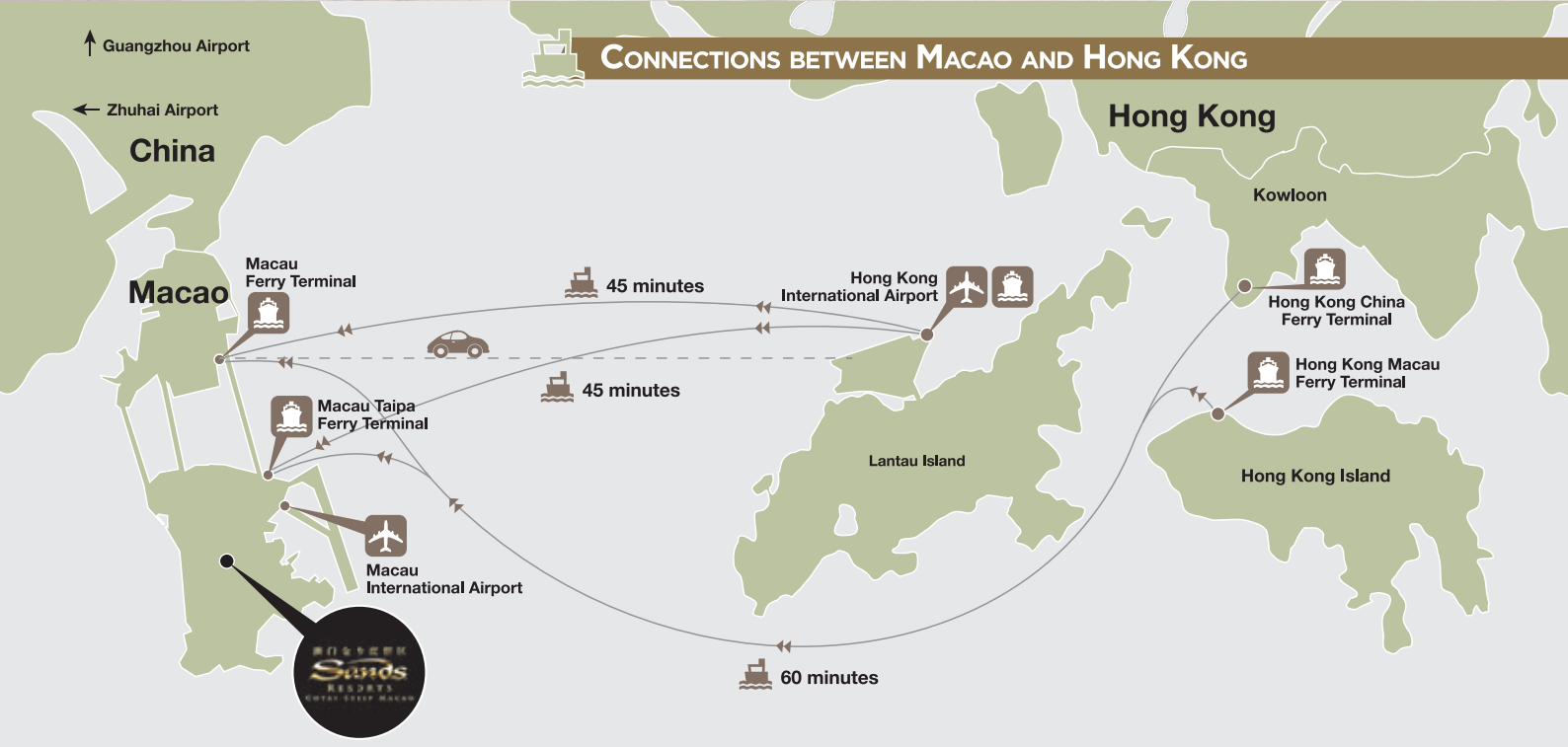

## Arriving in Macao by Land

**High Speed Train**  
There are several high speed trains that connect Macao to most cities in mainland China. Visitors can now connect from cities such as Beijing and Guangzhou, a trip of only 8 hours with the new high speed trains compared to 20 hours previously. From Guangzhou, visitors have the choice of a 46-minute non-stop train to Zhuhai, the Macao-mainland China border, or 3 hours by coach.

**The Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge**  
The Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge consists of a series of bridges and tunnels that will eventually connect Hong Kong, Macao and Zhuhai. When completed, the bridge will provide delegates with the opportunity of visiting Hong Kong and the southern part of mainland China by road or by rail in addition to visiting Macao.

**Macao Light Rapid Transit (LRT)**  
The Macau Light Rapid Transit (LRT) is a mass transit system in Macao currently under construction. It will serve the Macao Peninsula, Taipa and Cotai, connecting hotels, attractions, border gates, ferry terminals, and Macau International Airport.

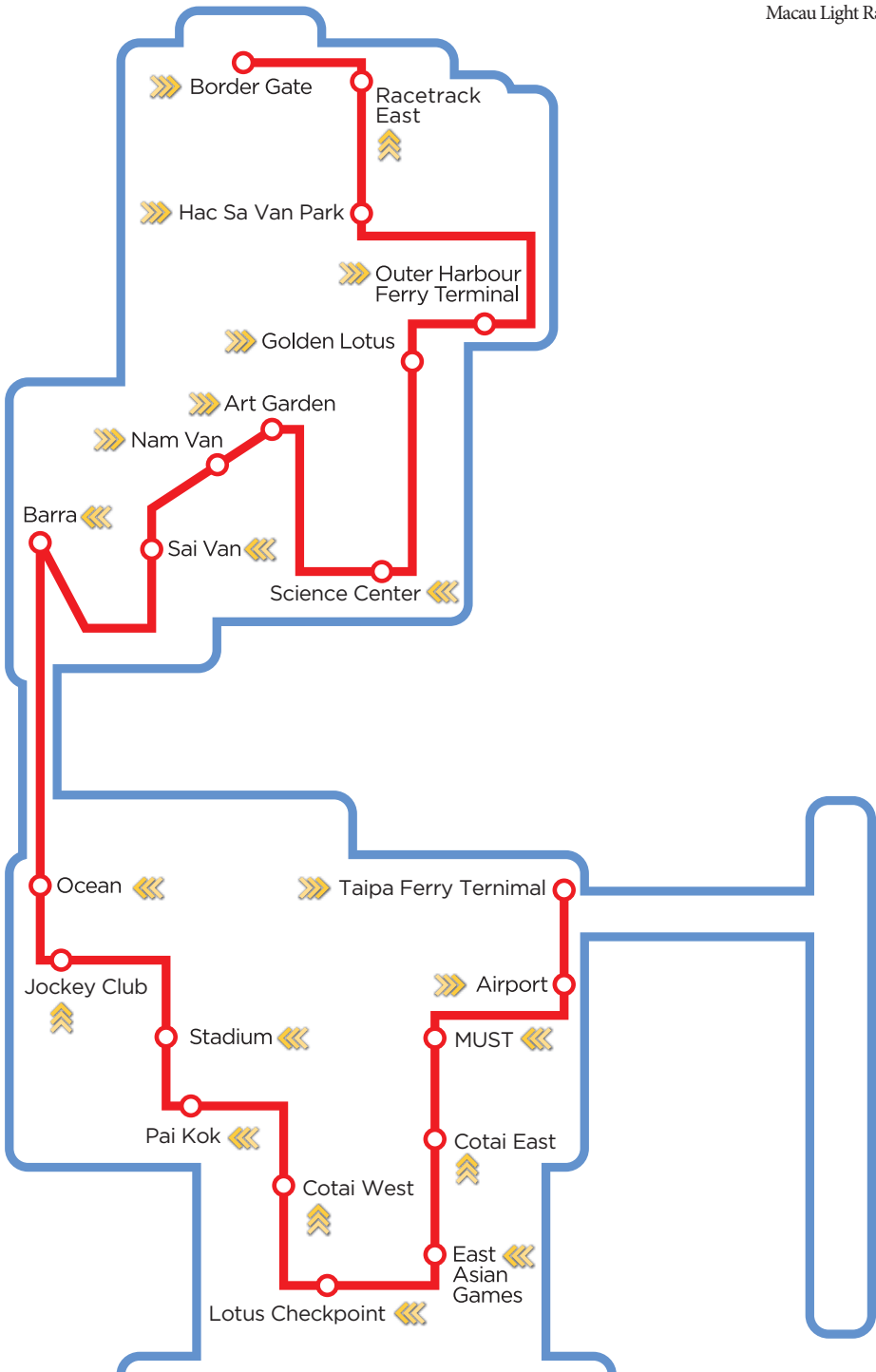
## The Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge

The Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge is an ongoing construction project which consists of a series of bridges and tunnels that will connect Hong Kong, Macao and Zhuhai. When it is completed, the 29km span will make it one of the world's longest bridges and is expected to reduce travelling times between Hong Kong, Zhuhai and Macao. With this easy access, an increased number of delegates will be able to reach Macao. In addition, the bridge will also provide delegates with the opportunity to visit Hong Kong and the southern part of China by road or by rail as well as visiting Macao. The multi-destination possibilities will enhance the delegate experience in the region.

## Macau Light Rapid Transit (LRT)

The Macau Light Rapid Transit is a mass transit system in Macao currently under construction. It will serve the Macao Peninsula, Taipa and Cotai, connecting hotels, attractions, border gates, ferry terminals, and Macau International Airport.
