The Venetian Macao Joins the Excitement for the 62nd Macau Grand Prix

The integrated resort will be sponsoring race cars for the Macau Road Sport Challenge and displaying Mercedes AMG at St Mark's Square

(Macao, Nov. 18, 2015) – The Venetian[®] Macao revs into top gear this weekend both on and off the track for the 62nd Macau Grand Prix which will be held on Nov. 19 - 22, 2015. This year, the resort will once again supporting the car racing spectacular by sponsoring five cars for the local Lotus team, adding a touch of the Venetian to the race – by featuring the golden logo of The Venetian Macao on the vehicles.

Aside from the racetrack, The Venetian Macao has partnered with luxury car brand Mercedes to showcase a Mercedes AMG SLS GT3 race car in St. Mark's Square at Shoppes at Venetian. The displayed car will be the the exact winning race car of last year. As a highlight this year, last year's winners Maro Engel and Renger Van der Zande will be on hand at the display for a meet and greet, as well as an autograph session at St. Mark's Square in the evening of Nov. 20. What's more, Mika Hakkinen – former Formula 1 champion and the AMG brand ambassador, will also be onsite for an autograph session on Saturday Nov. 21, from 5p.m. to 7p.m. Fans won't want to miss this great chance to meet the elites of the field in person.

Race fans and shoppers will also get the chance to checkout a replica of Mercedes AMG trophy that the team won in the 2014 Macau Grand Prix. Visitors will be able to take a picture on a specially designed podium next to the Mercedes AMG race car, and have their photos imbedded into a video where they will be put next to the Mercedes AMG champions. They can celebrate like a winner and take the video home. In addition, visitors can share the video directly to their WeChat and Weibo account. The Mercedes AMG SLS GT3 will be on display until Nov. 22.

For all fans who cannot make to the race itself, the 62nd Macau Grand Prix will be broadcast live on Sunday Nov. 22 from 12p.m. to 2:30p.m. at the Mercedes AMG car display at St Mark's Square at The Venetian Macao.

The Venetian Macao is also sponsoring five racing vehicles for Lotus team in Macau Road Sport Challenge. The five cars including Lotus Evora GTC and Lotus Exige models, will sport the Venetian logo on both sides. One of the cars will be driven by, 2014 HKAA Roadsport Challenge Whole Year Champion Eric Wong, while others by Robert Webb, Nattavude Charoensukhawatana, Bill Obrien and Anthony Chan.

When fans aren't at the track, they can enjoy all the dining, duty-free shopping and entertainment on offer at The Venetian Macao and Sands Resorts Cotai Strip Macao.
