Olympic gold medalists **Zou Shiming**, **Ryota Murata** and **Egor Mekhontsev**, from China, Japan and Russia, respectively, *plus* International Boxing Federation (IBF) world lightweight champion **Miguel "Titere" Vazquez**, of Mexico, return to the ring Saturday, February 22 for **Ring of Gold**.
