Sands China Continues Donation of Dry Food to Caritas Macau Over 300 food items donated by Sands China team members across all properties

(Macao, Feb. 20, 2014) – With the Year of the Horse just under way and an echo of prosperity still ringing in everyone's ears, Sands China Ltd. continued its support of Caritas Macau by initiating a team member food drive at each of its properties for the benefit of less privileged families in Macao.

Dry food collection stations were set up in staff areas at The Venetian[®] Macao and Sands[®] Cotai Central Feb. 17 and at Sands[®] Macao Feb. 18. Generous team members dropped by to offer their donations of such dry food items as rice, noodles, biscuits, canned foods, candy, and beverages. The donations to Caritas Macau will benefit homeless people, elderly and underprivileged families in Macao – those who do not have the means to sustain themselves and their families through adequate nutrition.
