Penguins Undercover Ice World with the DreamWorks Gang Wraps up at The Venetian Macao

Fourth year in Macao for ever-popular ice sculpture exhibition

(Macao, April 1, 2015) – Ice World, Asia’s largest annual indoor frozen wonderland, returned to the Cotai Expo at The Venetian Macao® for its fourth year between Nov. 27, 2014 and March 31, 2015.
