RESULTS FROM UFC FIGHT NIGHT[®] MACAO: BISPING vs. LE

(Macao, Aug. 23, 2014) – The Ultimate Fighting Championship[®] made a triumphant return to <u>The Venetian[®] Macao</u> Saturday, with the thrilling UFC FIGHT NIGHT[®] MACAO: BISPING vs. LE delivering an evening of adrenaline-pumping entertainment to a sold-out Cotai Arena audience of over 7,000.

The main event saw a middleweight clash between two veteran fighters, No. 8 ranked <u>Michael "The Count" Bisping</u> and Hollywood actor and former Strikeforce champion <u>Cung</u> <u>Le</u>. The co-main event featured: No. 4-ranked welterweight <u>Tyron "The Chosen One"</u> <u>Woodley</u> – whose wins include victories over former UFC champion Carlos Condit, Josh Koscheck, Paul Daley and Tarec Saffiedine – facing off with surging No.9 ranked <u>Dong</u> <u>Hyun "The Stun Gun" Kim</u>; Yang Jianping and Ning Guangyou battling it out in the Octagon[®] to become the featherweight winner of *The Ultimate Fighter*[®] *China* and win a coveted UFC contract; and the recently crowned *The Ultimate Fighter China* welterweight winner <u>Zhang Lipeng</u> returning to Macao to take on Australia's <u>Brendan O'Reilly</u> in the lightweight division.

Adding even more drama and excitement was a six-bout preliminary card that featured the first-ever women's UFC[®] match-up in Asia with American <u>Elizabeth Phillips</u> taking on Russia's <u>Milana Dudieva</u>.

Attending UFC Fight Night Macao as a special guest was undefeated UFC bantamweight champion and Olympian <u>Ronda Rousey</u>, who recently won the ESPY's 2014 award for top female athlete. Rousey's success and global appeal has helped grow the sport of women's mixed martial arts and in turn the growth of the sport in Asia. Rousey was joined by other guest fighters, including UFC middleweight fighter <u>Luke Rockhold</u> and *The Ultimate Fighter 20* strawweight contestant **Angela Magana**.

The star-studded event featured Octagon girls Jessica C and Rosemary Vandenbroucke, and was attended by a host of celebrities: Channing Tatum, Vaness Wu, Andy On, Philip Ng, Timmy Hung, Jimmy Hung, Toby Leung, and Hall of Fame boxing trainer Freddie Roach.
