

## Sands China Executives Celebrate Glory with Team Members Team wins big in 7th Macau Table Game Skills Contest



Held on Nov. 19 at the Macao Federation of Trade Unions Workers Stadium, the Macau Table Game Skills Contest recognizes the professional skills of those working in gaming and honours the best in the industry. The Sands China contingent was up against some of the best dealers in Macao but swept to victory, breaking all previous records in the history of the competition.
