Sands China Care Ambassadors Carry Out Annual Spring Cleaning for the Elderly in Macao

Ninety team members bring smiles to faces across the community

(Macao, Feb. 16, 2015) – Yesterday, a total of 90 Sands China Care Ambassadors (SCCA) volunteered to help brighten the homes and hearts of local elderly people who live alone. The senior citizens are users of the Peng On Tung Tele-Assistance programme which is supported by Sands China. This is the sixth consecutive year the spring cleaning initiative has been held, and it is now firmly an annual tradition prior to Chinese New Year. In addition to cleaning, SCCA volunteers delivered gifts to the residents and one volunteer hairdresser even provided a free haircut service to some residents.

Early Sunday morning, 90 Ambassadors armed with brooms and other cleaning tools boarded Sands China buses and travelled to several residential locations in Macao. They visited 25 households where they spent hours sweeping, vacuuming and scrubbing the homes. When they had finished, they sat down for a friendly chat with the occupants, with an ambassador offering free haircuts too. Each resident was also given a gift pack which contained useful staples such as rice, oil, grain and noodles.

In association with the Peng On Tung Tele-Assistance programme operated by The General Union for Neighbourhood Associations, Sands China has supported the programme since 2010, having contributed over MOP 1.1 million to the programme to date and benefitting more than 1,330 elderly people. Since 2010, SCCA volunteers have participated in home visits and spring cleaning among other services.

The Sands China Care Ambassador programme aims to give Sands China employees an opportunity to serve the local community by organising community activities and initiatives that work toward creating a better Macao. With a current membership of over 500 volunteers from across all Sands China properties – The Venetian® Macao, Sands® Macao, The Plaza™ Macao and Sands® Cotai Central – the Sands China Care Ambassadors have contributed over 4,800 hours of voluntary community service since the programme was

founded in August 2009. Sands China Ltd. considers initiatives like this central to its commitment towards social causes and community involvement.
