Asia's Biggest Movie Stars Descend on The Venetian Macao The Venetian Theatre hosts Asian Film Awards with glittering ceremony

(Macao, March 25, 2015) – The red carpet was rolled out at The Venetian Macao as the biggest names in the Asian movie business were in town for the 9th Asian Film Awards. Sponsored by Sands Resorts Cotai Strip Macao and The Venetian[®] Macao and with Cotai Water Jet as the Official Ferry Operator, the awards came to The Venetian Macao for the first time, and only the second time in the city, on March 25.

As one of the most prestigious film award ceremonies in world cinema, the **Asian Film Awards** routinely attracts the best and brightest from the movie business in Asia. This year was no different. With over 1,000 eligible films from 34 countries, narrowing the field down to just 14 category winners was a tall order for the 14-person jury, but eventually the winners were chosen, setting the stage for a fabulous night of glitz and glamour at The Venetian Theatre.

Led by Mabel Cheung with celebrity guest judge Aaron Kwok, the jury awarded 14 categories, including Best Film, Best Director, Best Actor, Best Actress, Best Supporting Actor, Best Supporting Actress, Best Newcomer, Best Screenwriter, Best Cinematographer, Best Production Designer, Best Composer, Best Editor, Best Visual Effects and Best Costume Designer.
