Ticket Information

1. How do I find location of the Exhibition and purchase tickets?

2. At what age do children have to buy a ticket?
All guests ages 3 and up require a ticket for entry. Children ages 2 and under are free to visit, and do not need a ticket. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all time. Due to restrictions within the venue, strollers are not permitted inside the exhibition.

5. What age is Harry Potter™: The Exhibition suitable for?
Guests of all ages can experience Harry Potter: The Exhibition, however, some immersive elements may be scary for young audiences.
6. What hours is the exhibition open?
The exhibition is open daily from 11:00am - 7:00pm; last admittance at 6:15pm.
7. How long will my visit take?
The exhibition is self-guided, and we expect guests to spend 60-90 minutes exploring.
8. Can I leave and come back?
Tickets for the exhibition provide one-time entry. Once guests are inside the exhibition, they may not re-enter. Should a guest need to step out of the exhibition for an emergency, please notify the nearest staff member.
9. What is the bag policy?
Oversized bags and backpacks may be asked to be checked at the hotel concierge during periods of high visitation. Service charge applies.
10. Is there a photo policy?
Small hand-held cameras and phones are welcome, but please note that we do not allow professional camera equipment such as external lighting and tripod. inside the exhibition. We encourage guests to take plenty of photos during their visit - feel free to tag us on social media @harrypotter_exhibition, #HarryPotterExhibition and #HarryPotterExhibitionMacao!
11. Can I bring my stroller and luggage inside the exhibition?
Please note that due to space limitations, strollers and luggage are not permitted.
12. Can I bring food and drinks inside the exhibition?
Food and drinks are not permitted inside the venue.

13. Is your exhibition accessible for guests with disabilities?
Yes! Each location is accessible to guests with limited mobility. For guests with hearing disabilities, closed captioning subtitles are available on most of the galleries' media screens.
14. How does this exhibit impact guests with sensory sensitivities?
Guests with sensory sensitivity should be aware that the exhibition features ambient music, sound bites from the films, non-strobe flashing lights, motion triggered sound and video, and other media moments throughout.
15. Can I dress up to visit the exhibition?

16. How is The Londoner Macao accessible by public transport?
Visitors have multiple options for arrival by public transport:

When arriving from Zhuhai - Hengqin Port/Gongbei Border Gate/Guangzhou/Zhongshan/Dongguan/Shenzhen:

Once in Macao, take the complimentary The Londoner Macao shuttle buses from the Gongbei Border Gate or from the Hengqin Port to The Londoner Macao. From Hong Kong:

Cotai Water Jet is the premium high-speed ferry service connecting Hong Kong and Macao. Upon arrival in Macao, complimentary shuttles rides will take you to the doorsteps of The Londoner Macao.

Valet Services are also available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year at Sands Resorts Macao. For Valet Services, please proceed to the hotel main entry for drop off and pick up. Charges apply as follows : MOP50 per hour thereafter to a maximum MOP600 per 24-hour period.
